

NICRA team visits to adapted village Chugawa in district Karnal on December 24, 2020

Under NICRA project one village has been adopted for improving dairy productivity through scientific interventions, methodologies and technologies developed by the NICRA team. Fifty dairy farming families will be selected from Chugawa village (district Karnal) for conducting field trails to validate the developed methodologies and technologies. The farmers will be provided technical as well as dairy inputs like mineral mixture, best quality semen, fodder seeds, health and deworming support. The generated data will be compared with other farmers of the same village who were not adopting scientific interventions and knowledge. The generated information will further be used in other villages of different climatic zones of the country by adopting one or two village of each zone.
