Subject: Sale/Auction of surplus pedigree animals at National Dairy Research Institute, Karnal on 22nd to 24th March, 2018.

Sir,

I, AAO (Store) on behalf of the Director, NDRI, Karnal state terms and conditions of animals auction as under:

The list of the animals of crossbred Friesian and Brown Swiss, Sahiwal Cows, Tharparkar/buffaloes, Goats, Heifers and bulls which are available at this Institute for sale in March, 2018.

1. SALE ON BOOK VALUE ON 22.03.2018

Since the State Govt. /Research and Teaching Institute and Universities have the priority to choose the animals, therefore, on 22.03.2018, the animals will be offered for sale to those on terms and conditions mentioned below:

- a) Based on the information given by the Incharge, Livestock Research Centre, NDRI, Karnal in the enclosed list, the State Govt. / Institute are required to select such animals as they desire to acquire and intimate their numbers & particulars to the Incharge, Livestock Research Centre on or before 22.03.2018 and send their representative with authority letter to attend the final allotment of animals on 22.03.2018 at 11.00 AM in the office of the Incharge, Livestock Research Centre, NDRI, Karnal.
- b) Animals to progressive farmers/Goshallas will be allotted on book value along with Govt. / Departmental agencies on the same day. The selection of progressive farmers/Goshallas will be done by a committee at NDRI. Those who are interested in allotment of animals under this category should apply to the Director, NDRI Karnal.

Criteria for selection of Progressive Farmers:-

- (i) He/she should be a land owner with holding not less than 5 acres
- (ii) He/she should be in possession of a minimum of 5 milking cows/buffaloes and the required facilities for proper upkeep of animals
- (iii) The application of a progressive farmer duly certified by an officer not below Deputy Director(Animal Husbandry) of a concerned district should be forwarded by a Member of Parliament through Minister of Agriculture/Minister of state (DARE and Animal Husbandry & Dairying) accompanied by a certificate that he/she is a progressive farmer.
- (iv) He/she should be a member of the milk cooperative.

(v) He/she should give an undertaking that he /she will not dispose off the animal for at least 1 year or one lactation whichever is earlier.

Criteria for selection of Goshalas

(i) Gaushalas should be in possession of a valid registration number and should be registered for at least past 5 years.

(ii) Should have at least 50 adults animals with adequate shelter fodder water and health care facilities and infrastructure.

(iii) Should not possess less than 25 acres of land for fodder production/pasture.

(iv) Gaushalas should have received partial financial assistance from central/state government agencies or the Animal Welfare Board of India(AWBI) at least once during past 3 years.

(v) Preference will be given to Gaushalas engaged in some development of animal husbandry activities in the area.

(vi) Gaushalas concerned will furnish the copies of the relevant records to the above effect duly certified by the authorities concerned which will be verified at the time of allotment on book value.

It is also clarified that not exceeding 40% of the total number of animals available in the category would be allowed to progressive farmers/Gaushalas/Govt. Deptts./agencies. Further a progressive farmer who has participated and purchased animals on book value will not be permitted to participate for next two years. He may however, participate in the open auction

- c) The final allotment of the animals to each State/Institute will be made by the Animals Distribution Committee.
- d) Immediately after the allotment of animals, the State Govt./Institute have to deposit Rs. 5000 (Five thousand) for each animals they have been allotted and make their own arrangements for lifting of the animals within 10 days from the date of allotment, failing which feeding [charges@Rs.200/- per](#) day per animals (above one year of age) and Rs.100/-per day per animals (below one year of age) will be charged from the concerned party. If the animals are not lifted within 10 days, the Institute will be free to dispose off these animals suitably and EMD of Rs.5000/- will be forfeited. No reservations will be made without deposit. After the allotment of animals, the State Govt./Institute have to lift all the animals allotted to them failing which their advance will be forfeited and feeding charges @Rs.200/- (Adult) and Rs.100/- (Young) from the date of allotment of next auction month will be charged.
- e) If payment is made in shape of Demand Draft, the Draft may be drawn in the name of **“ICAR UNIT NDRI, KARNAL”**.
- f) If there is any casualty of animal already allotted before the date of lifting, the security deposited will not be refunded.
- g) Consequent upon the transfer of the Institute from the Govt. of India to Indian Council of Agril. Research, it has been decided that prices of animals allotted to the State Govt. / Institutes will have to be paid as per the prescribed mode before the animals are lifted. At present no GST is applicable on sale of animals.

The State Govt/Institutes are, therefore, advised to ensure their representatives who are deputed to lift the animals allotted to them are provided with sufficient funds to meet the cost of such animals.

Young bulls listed here could be selected by State /organization and on written assurance, we will raise them and sell at Book Value plus feeding charges on future date.

2. SALE BY PUBLIC AUCTION ON 23.03.2018 (Cattle) and 24.03.2018 (Buffalo) AT 9.00 A.M.

The animals not allotted to the State Govt. / Institute on 22.03.2018 will be sold by Public Auction on 23.03.2018(cattle) & on 24.03.2018(buffalo) w.e.f. 09.00 A.M. to 05.00 P.M. at Livestock Research Centre, National Dairy Research Institute, Karnal. The general terms and conditions of the auctions are as under:

- a) The book value mentioned in the enclosed list has no relationship with the sale price of animals.
- b) The animals will be sold on “as is where is basis”. The bidder should examine the animals at the time of auction.
- c) The reason given for auction in the list (both in Category “A” and Category “B”) indicates the tentative basis on which the animal is being auctioned from the Institutes herd. Bidders should check the record and the animals for its health and productions status before auction. The Institute will not be responsible for any ailment or disorder or other discrepancies after the animals is auctioned.
- d) The bidder who wants to participate in public auction should registered with I.D. Proof and security money Rs.5000/- will be deposited to the Cashier, NDRI, Karnal against a token no. to be issued. The security money of Rs.5000/- will be forfeited if the highest bidder is not able to deposit the final bid value of the animal in the shape of Demand Draft or through Debit Card. However, the security money will be refunded to non-successful bidders after the bidding process is over.
- e) **The highest bidder will have to supply self attested photocopy of his identity proof (Ration card/PAN card/Driving license / Electricity bill/Voter card /UID etc.).** He will be responsible for lifting the animals within 24 hours and in case they fail to do so a sum of Rs.200/-per day animals (above 1 Year of age) and Rs.100/-per day per animals below the one year of age will be charged from them as feeding charges. The sold animals are to be lifted at the earliest failing which the whole amount paid for the purchase will stand forfeited.
- f) The highest bidders will have to deposit the whole amount of the bid in the form of Demand Draft/transaction through Debit Card of the bidder at the spot on the fall of the hammer. No part payment of the bids will be accepted. At present no GST is applicable on sale of animals. The bidders may take help of the SBI at NDRI for preparation of DD if required.
- g) The highest bidder will have to make their own arrangement for lifting the animals from the Institute on the same day or 24 hours.
- h) The Institute is not responsible for any harm/injury/death caused to auctioned animals from the time of auction onwards.
- i) The Director, NDRI, Karnal or the Chairman, Animals Auction Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the bids without assigning any reason.

j) All the disputes/ litigations, if any will be subject to Karnal jurisdiction only.

NB : :i) Information given is based on the records available in Livestock Research Centre and observations on animals on the date of preparation of lists which is about one and half to two months before the date of auction. The reasons given for auction are, therefore, indicative. Any change in the status of the animals known to the Auction Committee is announced at the time of auction. Bidders should inspect the animals at the time of auction for any deviation in the status of animals from the once mentioned in the list of animals under the column "reason for auction".

ii) There is a need to obtain permit for transportation of animals from Haryana State Territory. It is the responsibility of the Highest Bidder to obtain the permit
