

‘Input Distribution, Scientists-Farmers Interaction Session cum refresher training’ was organized at ERS of ICAR-NDRI under TSP Component

On 18.2.2018 one ‘Scientists-Farmers’ interaction session-cum-refreshers training was organized at ERS of ICAR-NDRI, Kalyani in collaboration with KVK, Nadia (addl.) under TSP project. More than 100 tribal farmers from Nadia district of West Bengal participated the programme. The Inaugural lecture was delivered by Dr. T.K. Dutta, Head, ERS of ICAR-NDRI. In the interaction cum training session Dr. M.K. Ghosh, Dr. A. Mandal, Dr. D.K. Mandal and Dr. A. Ghosh trained tribal farmers about different aspects of low cost goat and poultry farming in lower gangetic region. Dr. Nilmani Baidya, BLDO, Chakdaha explained about the management of goat and poultry birds by using locally available resources. The programme was coordinated by Dr. A. Mohammad. For securing livelihood of the tribal farmers 2000 RIR poultry birds and 30 female and 2 male ‘Black Bengal Goats’ were distributed among the tribal animal rearers. The assurance of continuous hand holding-cum-technical assistance pertaining to animal husbandry was given to tribal farmers from ERS of ICAR-NDRI, Kalyani.
